
The relationship between happiness and personality dimension with attitude of premarital

Abstract: The primary aim of this study was to investigate the relationship between happiness and personality dimensions with pre-marriage attitude. the population study between singles in the age group 20 to 40 years old were living in Rasht in 1395 that among them, 200 patients (102 men and 98 women) were ed by access method and they were compeleted Oxford Happiness Questionnaire, NEO-Five Factor, pre-marriage attitude. Data were analyzed using correlation and stepwise pearson and regression. The results showed that the pre-marriage attitude and components happiness between the components of personality dimensions (Extraversion and conscientiousness) a significant positive correlation and there is a significant negative correlation with neuroticism. The findings also show that overall satisfaction and extraversion about 27% of the variance components in the pre-marriage attitude and the three components of satisfaction, conscientiousness and extraversion In total, 24% of the orientation variance of the pre-marriage has forecasted. This study indicates the role of personality and happiness in premarital attitude that such results help to discuss the importance of premarital attitude variable; thus assessing the personality traits seems necessary.
