America is the only Western country that retains the death penalty and the fact that still uses the death penalty is similar to Iran. However, it should be noted that two key differences in the implementation of the death penalty in Iran and America there. Most penalties depriving the rights of life, religious and extent and cannot be changed. Second, look up and see the capital offenses in Iran's rights as well. America has had in several courses in law allows the death penalty completely stopped. The last of which was in 1967 and 1977 based on the Supreme Court's decision in the case of form came to a halt all executions in this period. The court was also argued that the death penalty is contrary to the Eighth Amendment to the constitution. The imposition of any cruel and unusual punishment in violation of the constitution knows. And on the other hand we are witnessing in America minimalistic look of the death penalty are This means that in states in America, only the most serious crimes, punishable by death. For example, in the state of Alabama only intentional killing an aggravating factor 18 (which is specified in state law) to have a death penalty. Or in another example, Kentucky murder with aggravating factors and kidnapping with aggravating factors are also considered capital. So that capital punishment does not exceed a maximum of three crimes. That way, at least one of the crimes of premeditated murder with aggravating factors such as murder and rape is now. But Iran's rights, We are facing the death penalty in choosing the optimal approach So that many crimes are punishable by depriving life.
