Abstract Knowledge-based economy in advanced countries, the developing interaction with the evolutions of the process of producing goods and services in these countries intensified. Added knowledge of the other factors of production has led to the development of knowledge economy, Combined with the global network economy, the new economy is said. The main objective of this study was to determine the factors associated with economic growth of Europe's knowledge-based economy.
