

The impact of developments on the geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Yemen

Yemen is a country located in the south of the Arabian Peninsula and proximity to the Strait of Bab el-Mandeb that is one of the main crossings of World trade as well as access to the rich oil resources with a Muslim population who half of them are Shia and can potentially effective actor in the appropriate regional relations. Recent developments in the country were important for regional and global powers. However, with the rise of the Islamic Republic of Iran in the region as well as the victory of Shiites in Yemen, the sensitivity of regional powers becomes more on the subject. On the other hand, because in the meantime the Islamic Republic of Iran for having the most power in the Middle East region has always influenced developments in this area, so is sensitive to developments in Yemen. We try to answer this question: what is the impact of Yemen developments on the geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic of Iran? The hypotheses is that Yemen's geographical location can affect Iran's geopolitical strategy and Yemen Shiite ideological issues can also affect the geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic. Our objectives in this thesis also includes an analysis of the impact of geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic of Yemen, describe the effective components of the geopolitical developments in Yemen and to provide appropriate solutions to exploit geopolitical developments in Yemen. Based on the results of this thesis, geographical components of Yemen against the Islamic Republic of Iran put opportunities and threats that these opportunities and threats has created some in the geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic of Iran that should be changed accordingly. The components of the Shias in Yemen because of affinity with Iran cause changes in the geopolitical strategy of the Islamic Republic of Iran.
