The Rules Governing International Commercial Arbitration in Cyberspace

Abstract One of the ways to settle disagreement is arbitration which is more wellknown in comparison to other methods. Although online arbitration is not apart traditional adjudication, but for the lack of some necessary conditions in cyberspace such as using paper physically, the validity of online judgment would go under question. These obstacles can be removed by interpreting international convention position. Instead it can be valid the same as traditional adjudication. Its validity would be appeared in time when all in situ standards in this respect followed through three steps: setting concordat; proceedings and issuing verdict all online. In accordance with this fact that most countries approved e-commercial laws, esignature and e-reasoning are verified, then the accuracy of concordats and validity of issued documents can be secured. Through it the appropriate basis could be provided to make and develop online arbitration.
