The impact of non-economic factors on foreign direct investment in Iran

Majority of developing countries face with a shortage of capital and financial resources. These countries, including Iran, for compensating the shortage of capital and financial resources need to attract foreign capitals. The aim of this study is to identify the uneconomical factors affecting foreign direct investment. The statistical population in this study consists of officials, and investment and economic experts of executive agencies of economic affairs and finance with the total number of 59 persons. The data collected through questionnaires, and in analyzing the data, the binomial test is used. The results showed that the entire infrastructures of sociopolitical and natural factors are effective in attracting foreign direct investment.
