The relationship between emotional intelligence and social support nurses' job satisfaction Rasool Akram Social Security Rasht

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Abstracts The main purpose of current inquiry was the relation between emotional intelligence and social support with job satisfaction of employed nurses in Rasul Akram hospital (Rasht). This study is a correlation. Statistic population of this study was all employed nurses of Rasul Akram social security hospital (Rasht) 1395(2016) that contain 193 nurses. This sample size were 125 which were randomly chosen and according Morgan draw; and evaluated by Sherbourne and Stewart social support scale (1991), Bar-On emotional intelligence questionnaire (1997) and Smith & Kendall, Hulin job satisfaction questionnaire (1969). Data was analyzed by Pearson correlation and Multi variables regression. Results which were obtained by Multivariate regression analysis showed that 0.063 percent of job satisfaction variation predict in main emotional intelligence hypothesis. The level of F which has been observed for predictor variable in 0.001 is significant. Results of correlation analysis showed that there is significant relation between emotional intelligence and job satisfaction in P
