Comparision between the Aspects of Hegsaco's Personality and Positive Thinking in Perfectionist Students and Non-Perfectionist Ones

Abstract the study investigates the comparision between hegsaco's personality aspects and positive thinking among perfectionist students and non-perfectionist ones. The study is a casual and comparative one. The comunity of the study included a group of perfectionist students and a group of non-perfectionist ones azad islamic university, branch of rasht. The sample include 140 individuals (70 perfectionist students and 70 non-perfectionist students) which were ed by sampling. First, they were evaluated by using a perfectionist quertionairy and then they were divided into 2 groups. Next, they were investigated by questionairy of hegsaco's persoality aspects and positive thinking. For analyzing the results, we used multi-variable and single-variable variance analysing. All of them were done using SPSS version 20. Data's analyses show that there is a significant difference between hegsaco's personality aspects positive thinking among perfectionist and non-perfectionist students. The results show that perfectionist students differ non-perfectionist students in personality aspects and positive thinking. So, it is suggested that the authors of the universities should consider specially helping the students in order to verify themselves.
