A comparative study of the role of the prosecutor in iran and the international criminal court

The aim of this study was to investigate the nature and extent of the prosecutor's action in national legal affairs and the International Criminal Court. It may be important considering the wide range of functions and powers of prosecutors in legal affairs and neglecting legal circles and writers to it. In this regard, in addition to identify the Prosecutor and similar institutions to discuss the historical record in Iranian and foreign law. We studied the laws of the prosecutor's action on legal affairs in both judicial and non-judicial and then, by acquiring a general understanding will be determined the basis of these functions and powers. According to various laws, the prosecutor is in charge of various tasks in civil law. In the current study is investigated the role of prosecutor at the statute of the international criminal court and Iranian criminal procedure and conducted a comparative study on some of the functions of prosecutor in Iran and the International Criminal Court. The results indicated that there are a significant differences between prosecutor's role in Iran and the international criminal court regarding execution of the judgment, appearance or non-appearance of the prosecutor at the trial and punishment type.
