Compare the maladaptive schemas, personality traits and Conflict resolution skills among Men with substance abuse and normal men

Abstract The aim of this research was to compare the maladaptive schemas, personality traits and Conflict resolution skills among Men with substance abuse and normal men. This study is causal - comparative. The statistical society of current research consisted of Men with substance abuse and also control group that were matched with the main group In terms of demographic variables (Including gender, age, place of living, education level, and marital status) in 2015 in Rasht city. In this research 240 people including 120 Men with substance abuse through random cluster sampling method and 120 normal men through available sampling method were ed and responded to maladaptive schemas, personality traits and Conflict resolution skills questionnaires. For sampling, Of the 16 Addiction Treatment center, the number of 5 center were ed randomly and researcher distributed the questioners to people who were Eligible for the study. Also researcher by visiting public places of those with no history of addiction ed by available sampling method. The gated data were analyzed by spss version 18 using Multivariate analysis of variance. The results showed that there exist significant differences between two groups of Men with substance abuse and normal men in terms of maladaptive schemas, personality traits and Conflict resolution skills So that the personality trait of neuroticism and maladaptive schemas are more common in Men with substance abuse (P
