# **The study of Quality of Life and Resiliency and Perceived social support of Women and men commit murder and Compare it with Ordinary women and men**

**Abstract** This study compared the psychological aspects such as quality of life, resilience and perceived social support in women and men committed the murder was compared to ordinary men and women. This research was the comparative method. The study population consisted of two groups. A group of men and women living in prisons commit murder Gilan Province 94-95 in the second group of ordinary men and women who had no criminal record. The sample consisted of 140 patients (70 women and 70 men guilty of murder and ordinary men and women) who are non-random sampling methods and choices available And using quality of life questionnaires the World Health Organization, resiliency, Connor Davidson and multidimensional perceived social support were examined. To analyze the data, the descriptive statistics (mean and standard deviation) and inferential statistics (ANOVA univariate and multivariate) were used. All data analysis was performed using SPSS-ver20 software. The results showed that the quality of life and dimensions and resiliency score there is a significant difference between the two groups And mean comparison showed a high degree murder offenders than it was in normal people But in terms of perceived social support only significant difference between the two groups. after important people support and no significant differences in other aspects. According to the findings of this study can be said that psychological aspects such as quality of life, resiliency and social support And the dimensions can be criminal penalty and the prevention of such cases to be considered.
