

# **Affiliated relationship with delinquent peers, attachment styles and interaction with parents with high risk behaviors in students**

The broad concept of risky behavior is a series of behaviors that not only brought serious losses for people with high-risk behaviors and important people in his life, but also causes unintentional harm to other innocent people. The most commonly harmful behaviors include high-risk driving, drugs, risky sexual behaviors, alcohol, drugs and cigarettes. In general, due to the importance of preventing high-risk behaviors among adolescents, the present study aims to investigate the relationship of affiliation with delinquent peers, attachment styles and interaction with parents with high-risk behaviors in students. This research methodological is correlation. The statistical population of this study includes all sixth male grade students working in public schools in district 2 of Rasht city education in 2017-2018 school year that 250 people of them were selected according to the available sampling method. To collect the data in this study, a questionnaire of association style with delinquent peers (2003), the Collins and Reid Attachment Styles Questionnaire (1990), Fidel et al.'s parent-child assessment questionnaire (1983), and the Risky Behavior Questionnaire of Mohammadi, Ahmad Abadi and Heidari (2007). For data analysis, the correlation and multiple regression methods were used. Analysis of the data showed that there is a positive and significant relationship between the association with delinquent peers with high risk behaviors ( $p$
