The survey of effect of financial development on poverty in Iran

Poverty is the inability to meet some needs, and many poor people still live despite the implementation of various poverty reduction policies. Poverty reduction has become one of the major goals of the world, and in this framework, the loss of poverty as one of the main pillars of the millennium development goals has been considered by the international community.
