Abstract One of the poetic styles in the Persian literature is description of virtues originated eulogy in which the poet sometime describes the outstanding traits of religious leaders. In the Persian poetry, this method has a long history remained so far. Imam Ali is the first Imam of Shiites whose admirable traits and characteristics were mentioned and admired in many poems. This research is conducted through a descriptive-analytical method and aims to study the contemporary poetry in terms of virtues written about Imam Ali in the poems based on the poems of five elected poets, including Mohammad Hossein Shahriyar, Mehrdad Avesta, Moshfegh Kashani, Ali Moosavi Garmaroodi and Hamid Sabzevari. Results obtained the research showed that these poets focused on two sections of inner characteristics and personality of Imam as well as his behavioral features and life style. In the virtues relating to the personality of Imam, his wisdom and greatness have been highly emphasized and in the section of behavioral virtues, the courage, warfare and succession of Imam Ali have been focused. Furthermore, it was determined that objective complements and subjective adjectives were used by poets more than other adjectives, respectively.
