## Domestic violence laws against women in Iran

Abstract: Today, violent violations of the law have been established for women in different countries. In our country, several criminal laws have been passed to protect women against various forms of violence, which are sometimes discriminatory and in some cases even more advanced than the cases are in international documents. These rules can be divided into three broad categories: - Protecting women against crimes against physical integrity, including all forms of physical violence, such as murder, assault, and abortion. Embryos, etc. - Protecting women against crimes against spiritual integrity, including all forms of violence Sexual and psychological abuse such as: insult, rape, pornography, trafficking in women for sexual exploitation, - protecting women against domestic crimes, such as domestic violence, spouse and relative relatives, etc. Our country has accepted most of the international instruments, especially documents related to the protection of women against sexual offenses, and amended and amended them, but did not accept any documents that were in conflict with the Shari'a rules, which were to take steps to comply with the established principles It is necessary in these documents with religious standards. The main cause of violence against women can be discriminated against, which impedes the equality of women with men at all levels of life. Many girls and women are not willing to report domestic violence to the police, or the judiciary in some countries does not deal with complaints in this area and considers them a private matter, and domestic violence statistics are not accurate and reflect the facts. However, the statistics are still shaky. Research findings show that most violence against women is based on ideological, tribal, and tribal prejudices, and that women's insight into the source of this is necessary. The direction of the educational authorities and the judicial institutions should be reduced to reduce the volume and ignored cases are also criminalized by the legislator.
