
Relationship between internet dependency and anxiety and loneliness in infertile women in Rasht

Abstract: when the internet first entered the human life is to this day, despite all the advantages the internet imposes a series of disadvantages on family and society. Infertile women as second class of society that many society and emotional stress incur and the internet as information source or mental evacuation shelter, are used as the target group studied. Metods is cross-sectional. this study on 228 infertile women who referenced to Azahra and Rasoul akrams governmental hospital and mehr barrenness institution in rasht city gradual sampling was don .data were gathered collected by standard questionnaires testing internet dependence Yonung (IAT), Beck Anxiety inventory questionnaire and Russll loneliness questionnaire 7 third edition . Statistical analysis of data , to verify that the predictor variables(dependence on the internet) and criterion variables (anxiety and loneliness)it has been advanced focus correlation analysis .The results indicate that multivariate variance results on the set of variables of loneliness and anxiety criteria in infertile women . The results of focal correlation analysis show that the focal relation between predictor variables is statistically signification (p
