The role of social responsibility and quality of life in predicting occupational stress of nurses

Abstract Goal: today's human being, in compatibility with his occupation and social environment, faces limitations and pressures which causes job stress for staff. This matter reduce the quality of life. This research aims to study the role of social responsibility and quality of life in predicting job stress in nurses of Rasht city. Method: research method is correlative and statistic population include all nurses of Rasht city (420 Individuals). Sample was ed via Quota sampling method and 194 nurses were ed. Data gathering tools include: Tufts & Gary Anderson Job stress questionnaire (1981), The World Health Organization Quality of Life Questionnaire (1989) and Inventory social responsibility (2013). Results were analyzed using Pierson correlation test and Multivariate regression in SPSS v19 Software. Findings: Pierson correlation test show that there is significant and negative relation between social responsibility and job stress (p
