Comparison of Stress Coping Strategies, Attachment Styles and Resilience of Workers and Normal Children in Tehran

This research was conducted to study comparatively the stress coping strategies, attachment styles and resiliency of working and normal children in Tehran. In a causal-comparative design, 100 working children were ed based on the available sampling and 150 normal children were ed through the purposive sampling. Both groups answered the Endler and Parker's Coping Inventory of Stressful Situations (CISS-21), Collins and Reid's Revised Adult Attachment Scale (RAAS), and Connor-Davidson's Resilience Scale (CD-RISC). The results through SPSS®-16 and based on MANCOVA after regulating the differences in age and academic years showed that the major effect of group subscription has had a significant effect on the scores of emotion-focused style [$\acute{\eta}$ 2=0.063, F(1,245)=16.45, P
