

Role of Mothers parenting styles and family cohesion in explaining children's aggressive behaviors

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One of the important reasons for the formation of behavioral problems, including aggressive behavior in children, can be problems in mother's parenting and insufficient coherence in family structure. The purpose of this study was to determine the role of mothers parenting styles and Family cohesion in explaining children's aggressive behaviors. The research method was descriptive correlational and predictive equation. The statistical population of the present study included all students of the fifth and sixth grade of elementary school in Rasht in the second semester of the academic year 2018 at approximately 1200 individuals. Based on Morgan's table and the research findings related to the research topic and the criteria for entering and leaving the research, a random sampling method of 70 random sampling method was used Bumerind parenting styles questionnaire (1973), the Family cohesion of Samani (2002) and the aggression of Shahim primary school children (2006). Data were analyzed using Pearson Correlation Coefficient and multiple regression analysis. The findings of this research showed that there is a negative and significant relationship between motherly reassurance and family cohesion with aggressive behaviors of children and there is a positive and significant relationship between the authoritative and authoritative parenting style of adoptive parenting and aggressive behaviors in children (P

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
