

Compare The Style of Lovemaking, Personality Characteristics And Family Function in Normal And Conflicting Couples Referred to Counseling Centers in Rasht

One of the most important problems in marital life is a phenomenon called conflicts and differences that can cause marital disturbances and even divorce. The present study compares the style of love making, personality traits and the main family function in normal and conflicting couples referring to Rasht city counseling centers. This is a descriptive and comparative study. The statistical population of this study is two groups. The first group of couples referred to counseling centers and the second group included all married couples residing in Rasht who were homogeneous in terms of socioeconomic components with couples who referred to counseling centers. Sample size consists of 160 couples (80 conflicting couples and 80 normal couples) who were ed by competitive sampling method and normal women by targeted sampling. A questionnaire of love style, personality traits and family function was used to examine the subjects. To analyze the results, multivariate analysis of variance was used. The findings showed that there is a significant difference between the love making style, personality traits and family function in normal and conflicting couples. According to the findings of this research, it can be concluded that love making styles, personality traits and family functioning can be effective factors in the stability of marital life.
