A house for child labor in order to reduce behavioral abnormalities

Despite the inalienable role of children in the society health and its dynamism, beside importance of childhood impact on human lives, yet millions of children are working all around the world, for reasons including poverty, family traditions and cultural structures, in the face of preventing and restricted laws and regulations. Effects of the difficult living conditions caused by work on the streets, has created trauma and mental behavioral disorder for many of those children. Given the direct impact of the environment on children growing up, the space is actually shaping performance and the performance of space, causing the child's behavior. This thesis has been carried out based on processing the data obtained field research involving direct contact with children, interviews with psychologists, experts and library studies and it has been tried to design a "Secure House" focusing on five major parameters as education, accommodation, recreation and entertainment, medical therapy and training and by using psychology and qualitative criteria in the design of the space environment, taking an effective step to improve mental health and curing behavioral disorders of child labors, as much as possible and as a final point with architectural solutions, prepare them as ordinary citizens to participate in our community.
