## Geopolitical analysis of Iran-Saudi relations with an approach to the developments in Syria

The Islamic Republic of Iran and Saudi Arabia, as two regional powers, have long been known as two main rivals in the Middle East. In recent years, relations between the two countries have become more complex and new dimensions. Meanwhile, one of the issues that has complicated the dark ties between the two countries in recent years is the Syrian crisis and civil war. In the course of the Syrian crisis, the Islamic Republic of Iran and Saudi Arabia have adopted contradictory positions based on their specific interests and interests in Syria. So, in this dissertation, the author uses descriptive analytical method and utilizes library studies in order to achieve the research goals and answer the research question, which are the effects of Syrian developments on Iran-Saudi Arabia geopolitical relations? Step is taken.
