Relationship between family function and parenting style with attachment style and identity of offspring of female head of household

Abstract The main purpose of this study was to investigate the relationship between family function and parenting styles with identity styles and attachment styles. The statistical population of the study included young children of female heads of households who referred to the Relief Committee. Using a suitable sampling method, 200 children randomly were ed as the sample. The research scales included family function questionnaire, attachment styles, parenting styles, identity styles. Using the correlation and multiple regression tests, the hypotheses of the research were examined and the results indicated that between the safe attachment style of children (correlation coefficient: -0.134), child avoidance attachment styles (correlation coefficient: -0.195) with Family function has a significant correlation. There is a significant correlation between the information identity style of children (correlation coefficient: 0.231), normative identity style of children (correlation coefficient: 0371) with family function. There is a significant correlation between the safe attachment style of children with Authoritarian parenting style (correlation coefficient: -0.232), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.323), Permissive parenting style (correlation coefficient: -0.362). There is a significant correlation between the ambivalent attachment style of children with Authoritarian parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.275), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: -0.289), permissive parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.301). There is a significant correlation between Avoiding Attachment Style of children with Authoritarian parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.333), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: -0.472), Permissive parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.208). There is a significant correlation between the Informational identity style with the authoritarian parenting style (correlation

coefficient: -0.340), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.379), permissive parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.229). Also, there is a significant correlation between the normative identity style with Authoritarian parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.211), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.326). In the following, there is a significant correlation between the avoiding identity style of children with the authoritarian parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.370), authoritative parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.231), Permissive parenting style (correlation coefficient: 0.330).
