The role of maternal parenting styles in predicting social skills and the creativity of female students

Parents' parenting styles and their relationships with children can determine many of the child's psychological and social characteristics. The purpose of this study was to determine the role of mothers' parenting styles in predicting social skills and creativity of female students. The research method was descriptive correlational and predictive equation. The statistical population of this study included all female students of fifth and sixth grade elementary schools in the city of Fouman in the first semester of the academic year of 2018 at approximately 460 and Among them, according to Morgan's table, 160 female students and Their mothers were ed Random cluster sampling method and Bamrind's childbirth styles (1973), Matson's social skills (1983), and the study of the multi-tasking of the paper pencil of Torrance's creativity assessment (1994) completed. Data were analyzed using Pearson Correlation Coefficient and multiple regression analysis. Findings showed that there was a significant negative relationship between creativity and light parenting style score (P
