## The Role of Temperament and Character, Attachment Style and resiliency in Explaining Addiction Potentiality

The Role of Temperament and Character, Attachment Styles and Resiliency in Explaining Addiction Potentiality in Girl Students. Substance abuse and addiction as one of the most important mental and social throne of this century, therefore different strata epically teenager and youth, this research purpose was to investigate the relationship between temperament and character and attachment style and resiliency in tendency to abuse drug in high school girl students. This research is correlation type research statistical population in all high school students of Rasht city in the academic years 1395-96 that 250 students of them were ed through cluster sampling method. kloninger s Temperament and character questionnaire and Kolins and Reed s attachment style scale and Davidsons s resiliency questionnaire and scale of potential to addiction (Ahvaz) that were used to collect data. The result of analysis showed that among the dimension of temperament and character novelty seeking and harm avoidance have positive and significant correlation with potentially addiction and reward dependency and persistence and self-direction and cooperativeness have negative and significant correlation with potential addiction. There is significant negative correlation with addiction among secure attachment style and avoidance with addiction potentiality. Also there is negative and significant correlation between resiliency and potential addiction. Additionally, Regression analysis results show that predictor variables predicted 0/032 of validity variance (P
