

The relationship between parenting styles and aggression and mental retardation in Students of Islamic Azad University Rasht Branche

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The main objective of this study was to investigate the role of parenting styles with aggression and psychological resilience in students. The study is correlation studies. The population in this study included all students of Islamic Azad University of Rasht. It was found that the total number of these persons is 7900 people. Sampling in this study is convenience non-probability sampling. According to Krejcie & Morgan, the sample for the population is 367 people. The students responded to Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale (CD RISC) (2003), Baumrind Scale parenting styles (1973) and Buss & Perry Aggression Questionnaire (1992). Results were analyzed using Pearson correlation and multivariate regression analysis. Multivariate regression analysis showed that psychological resiliency and aggressive predict 11% and 18% of parenting style changes, respectively. There is a significant relationship between psychological resilience parenting style (sig= 0.000. r=0.340) and between aggressive and parenting styles (sig=0.000, r=0.367(.
