

The Relationship between Psychological Capital and Life Expectancy with Marital Adaptation of Veterans' wives in Rasht

Marital adjustment of veterans' spouses affects a variety of factors, including psychological capital and life expectancy. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between psychological capital and life expectancy with marital adjustment of veterans veterans of Rasht city The statistical population of this study consisted of all spouses of veterans of Rasht city in the last quarter of 1397 in approximately 850 people. A sample of 250 individuals was ed according to the Morgan table, the history of research related to the topic of research, and the criteria for entry and exit of the research were ed using available sampling method. Then, Benjamin et al. marital adjustment (1995), Lutangs psychological capital (2007), and Schneider et al. (1991), completed their questionnaires. The data were analyzed using Pearson correlation coefficient and multiple regression. The results showed that there is a positive and significant relationship between total score of psychological capital and self-efficacy, hopefulness and resiliency components with the compatibility of veterans' spouses (P
