

Impact of Prison Sentence on Repetition of Victims by Male Inmates(Case Study: Lahijan City)

It is very important to pay attention to the issues and problems arising prison, especially the case of the subject what we are in. This requires the full cooperation and assistance of the three forces as well as the people of the community and perhaps the prisoners themselves. This is not a one-sided affair that only affects the prison community, but the whole community as its main victim, since the repetition of the crime will disturb its order, security and peace. Therefore, the aim of all penal systems in recent years has been to reduce the use of this punishment and eliminate its destructive effects. To this end, actions have been taken, such as the adoption of numerous laws and bills and regulations, as well as holding numerous conferences and workshops at the national and international level, and establishing different rules and provide different solutions. In the meantime, the applicable solutions in the Iranian penal system have been identified and explained and presented in this thesis. The principle question of the current study is what factors influence the possibility of committing crimes after first conviction and return to prison. This was a causal and survey study using questionnaire and interview method. The population of this study consisted of 345 inmates Lahijan city who are in prisons in the eastern province of Gilan in 2017. The statistical sample comprised of jailbird who had returned to provincial prisons by 2016, and 180 of repeat offenders according to the Prisons Office. The sample size was 60 individuals who were ed based on the Cochran sample size formula. The results of this paper provided some strategies that help prevent and reduce the incidence of crime and return prisoners to prison, such as standard implementation of separation and classification of inmates in prisons, improving their housing and maintenance status and the type of services they provide, removing of official and unofficial label of released prisoners, providing effective services and control through the after-care center, accepting released prisoners among family,

friends and formal and informal institutions and avoiding their rejection.
