

Election in Religious Democracy in the Digital Age, with an Emphasis on the Cconcept of "Power of Attorney"

Elections are one of the prominent manifestations of religious democracy in the Islamic Republic. Since the beginning of the revolution, the elections of the Islamic Consultative Assembly have always been accompanied by challenges and dilemmas, and have been subject to various debates, amendments, or proposals, such as provincialization, etc., throughout the Majles. In this research, by attempting to pathologically list the criticisms and challenges of the system such as monitoring and responding to the behavior and performance of the deputies, the propaganda mechanism of the candidates, the possibility of dismissing the MP, To be extracted by people and so on. Then, with a new approach, to get rid of all the criticisms and objections to the shaping and quality of parliament, considering the areas of digitization of society's processes and the use of new tools in democratic processes and electoralisation as one of the important requirements In the near future, a "House of Representatives" plan has been introduced to address the existing disadvantages and problems, by, according to the Electoral Code, each person will vote for only one person under one national code and in a transparent manner for one year, and By the end of the year, it was possible to withdraw the vote and move it to another The national code will be made transparent to him. The quorum of the House of Representatives shall be the total number of persons eligible to vote in the House of Representatives.
