The natural resistance of humans to foreign requirements in private law, "their conventions and conditions," respects the institution and establishes the principle of freedom to live in the desired manner. An unfair contract is an agreement in which the principal price paid is more or less fair market price. Unfair terms and conditions shall apply to the following: 1. Avoid any contract in its entirety; 2. Revoke the contract; 3. Exit a contract the terms of the contract for the benefit of the contracting party.
