

The Futurology of Geopolitical Conflict of Shiite and Zionist Regime in Southwest Asia

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Since the Zionist regime was established in the center of the Islamic world in an arbitrary and imposed manner in Southwest Asia and the Shiite nature is based on self-sacrifice, arrogance, justice, so the geopolitical confrontation between Shiite and Zionism is not to be expected in the future.
