
Information Requirements of Guilan Agricultural Jihad Experts on Trends and Advances in Agricultural Sciences

The development of human resources is equated with the change and development of knowledge, attitude and skill of the human resources through the process of education. Evidence shows that the level of empowerment of individuals in organizations is directly related to the amount of training given to individuals in organizations. Therefore, education is one of the key keys to the success and progress of the organization. Obviously education needs to be planned. Planning for human resources training in the organization also requires a needs assessment. Therefore, in order to increase the productivity of the human resources hired to help develop the agricultural sector, their professional development needs should be identified and addressed. The purpose of this study was to evaluate the information needs of experts of Agricultural Jihad Organization of Guilan about trends and developments in agricultural sciences. The statistical population of this study includes all the experts and experts of Guilan Agricultural Jihad Organization. Using the minimum sample size table of Bartlett et al. And cluster sampling method, 122 individuals were ed as the sample. Data analysis was performed using SPSS software. The results showed that areas such as Sustainable Development Goals, Multifunctional Agriculture and Farmers' Organizations were ranked as the top three, thus Consolidated Agriculture was the lowest. The measured priority scores also indicate that all thirty-eight inputs with high educational need for agriculture are in high demand. Results of t-test and analysis of variance showed that gender, education, courses, age, work experience, and organizational position had no significant effect on attitude at 0.05 level and only educational discipline had significant effect on attitude at 0.05 level. She has.
